



Kent Cornucopia Cup Soccer Tournament July 9-12, 2009



Volunteer Job Descriptions:

Field Marshal: The Field Marshal is the tournament representation for the game. Prior to the game the Field Marshal will greet both team coaches and referees. The remote locations will also call (or text) in the scores to the Registration desk at the Peapatch.

●Other Duties (when needed):

Getting new game ball if required by referee. Keeping Spectators away from the 18 yard box toward the center of the field (only necessary if spectators are cheering in that zone). Assisting with injured players. Making sure anyone ejected from the game, leaves the field. Keep the soccer fields clean of all garbage.

Parking Lot Attendant: (Pea Patch Location only)

Duties:

- 1: Be sure that no cars are blocked.
- 2: Utilized the space in the most efficient way.
- 3: Emergency access areas are not blocked.
- 4: Registration area is reserved for; Tournament director, Tournament committee members and coaches that are there to only register.
4. Handicaps spots are reserved for those needed.
5. Peapatch Gardeners: Those who are coming to tend their garden at the Peapatch are to park at the South Lot as well.

Garbage:

PeaPatch Location: This person will be responsible for picking up garbage on the fields. Changing the garbage on cans when necessary. Tying and setting to the side full garbage bags for later pick up.

Pre/Post Tournament Preparations and Clean up:

This is a great job for those who want to be free during 'game time' but is a vital job for the tournament.

- Set up: being there to help with whatever jobs are necessary. Setting up Garbage cans, Tables, Tents, running errands.
- Post game: the reverse of the set up. Taking down the nets, garbage, tables. Cleaning up the field.

Field Set up: Assisting in setting up the nets, flats, goals, and lining the fields.
